VISION

1. To provide individualised long term and respite residential services to persons with disabilities in full respect of their rights and dignity.
2. To promote the holistic personal development and social inclusion of service users, including their autonomy and self-determination.
3. To provide opportunities to employees to develop their skills and to enhance the value of their work.
4. To provide a meaningful experience of volunteering.
5. To collaborate with other organisations active in the field of disability to safeguard the rights of persons with disabilities and of their families.

VALUES

The values of *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* are rooted in the Gospel teachings. We believe that human life is unique and sacred, having equal and unconditional value. We profess an intrinsic respect for all persons, regardless of their strengths and abilities.

The general public is invited to submit proposals for a new logo of *Id-Dar tal-Providenza*.

BACKGROUND

Id-Dar tal-Providenza was founded in 1965 by Mgr Michael Azzopardi whose vision was to create a home for persons with disabilities. Since then, *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* has offered residential and respite services to a number of persons with disabilities in an environment which ensures them a good individual quality of life in full respect of their human dignity.

As *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* prepares to celebrate its 50th anniversary, it would like to create a new logo which reflects its vision, mission and values. The logo will be used online, in print and on merchandise. Flexibility is a key requirement, such as easy resizing and its adaptation in monochrome or colour.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Participants should provide, both in colour and in monochrome, the proposed logo in high resolution PNG/JPEG/TIFF formats. Other types of format will NOT be accepted. Designed logos should be sent electronically to logocompetition@dartalprovidenza.org. The submissions should include a short description of the motivation for the design and its graphic derivation.

The limit on attachment sizes for our email is 5Mb. If your submission exceeds this size, send the images individually and note clearly in your emails that you are doing so.

The successful logo design must be provided in vector format (EPS) upon request following the conclusion of the competition.

RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

Participants must own full copyright of the design. If requested, they must be able to certify ownership. Participants warrant that their entries are their own original artwork. Group submissions are welcome. Participants under the age of 18 must have parental or guardian consent to participate.

All submitted proposals will be considered confidential. Proposals that have not been selected will not be used for any other commercial or non-commercial use.

By submitting logo entries for consideration, all entrants affirm and acknowledge that *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* will have indefinite property rights and the right to use or display the winning logo in any matter and at any time. *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* will hold the right to distribute the logo to third parties to promote its cause and activities and for any other purpose to further its mission.

A selection panel shall be appointed to advise *Id-Dar tal-Providenza*. Decisions taken by *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* are final. *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* is not liable for any late, misrouted, damaged or lost entries or incorrect information supplied in the submission form.

Id-Dar tal-Providenza reserves the right to suspend, cancel or modify the competition process.

The submissions, in accordance with the requirements above, should reach *Id-Dar tal-Providenza* not later than **30 November 2013**.

Certificates of participation will be presented to all entrants. The winner shall be awarded a unique commemorative trophy.
